

### How do I know if my golf cart is eligible for coverage?

If your golf cart is less than current +6 model years, with a minimum of 6 months original manufacturer's full warranty then Xtended has coverage options available. Xtended Golf Cart includes coverage options for golf carts with the following:

- Powertrain Performance Modifications
- Suspension/Tire Modifications
- Snowplows
- Commercial Use
- Hybrid/Electric Engines

### Does the Xtended Golf Cart program need to be sold at the same time as the unit?

No. Xtended Golf Cart offers a Post Sale program that allows your customers to purchase coverage after the time of sale of the unit. This allows you to offer coverage to your customers as the manufacturer's warranty is expiring or when they visit your service department for repairs. As long as the unit is eligible for Xtended Golf Cart coverage, you can utilize the Post Sale Program.

### Is there an additional cost for the Post Sale Program?

If the vehicle is classified as "New", then there is no additional cost. Vehicles that qualify as "Used" do attract a small surcharge. This will be added to the contract cost when you identify that the vehicle purchase date is prior to the contract purchase date when generating a contract on the Xtended Golf Cart portal.

### Do Post Sale Units require an inspection?

No, there is no special inspection required for the post-sale program. However, we do suggest that all dealerships do an in house inspection on the unit prior to selling any post sale contracts as pre-existing conditions are not eligible for coverage.

### What is "New" coverage eligibility?

A new unit is any unit that has at least 30 days of original full manufacturer's warranty remaining.

### What is the Xtended Golf Cart claims limit?

The total limit that will be covered per claim is the value of the golf cart immediately prior to the mechanical failure. The total aggregate claims limit that will be paid out for the duration of your coverage is the purchase price of the unit.

### Is there a deductible?

Yes, New units have a \$0 deductible, with Used units having a \$50 deductible, unless the buy down option is purchased.

### Are commercial units eligible for coverage?

Yes, Xtended offers coverage options for units used for non-personal use such as rental, shuttle, military, fire, police, route work or any "for hire" business. Commercial use **does not** include golf course fleets or golf course fleet use.

### Is there trailer coverage options?

Yes. There is coverage for the following components of a trailer carrying an approved unit:

**Brake Components:** master cylinder, hydraulic brake actuator and backing plates

**Frame Components:** axle(s), brackets, bunks, couplers, fenders, hubs, roller cradles, spring hangers, welds and winch stands

**Suspension Components:** springs

### When do the terms start?

**New:** Term starts after the factory warranty has expired

**Used:** Term starts on the date of sale of the contract

**Post Sale:** Term starts on the date of sale of the contract with a 30 day waiting period for claims
